Matthew Diczok is managing director and head of Fixed Income Strategy for the Chief Investment Office (CIO) within Bank of America Corporation. He is responsible for driving and coordinating overall fixed income investment strategy and is a major contributor to the fixed income thought leadership publications. He helps drive the investment thinking supporting Bank of America Private Bank and Merrill.

Previously, Matthew was head of the Portfolio Solutions Desk, which delivered investment ideas and asset allocation guidance to financial advisors for Merrill.
